**Supports Mental Well-Being**

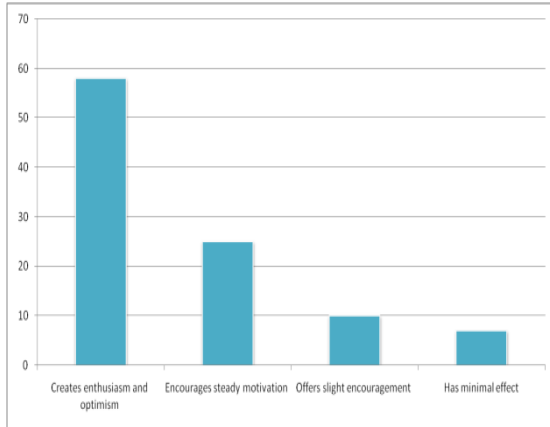

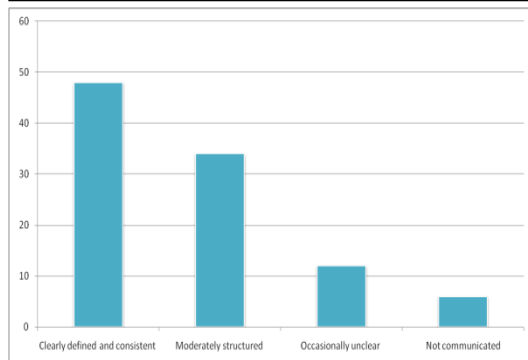

### 2. Is Kotak Life Insurance's appraisal process transparent?

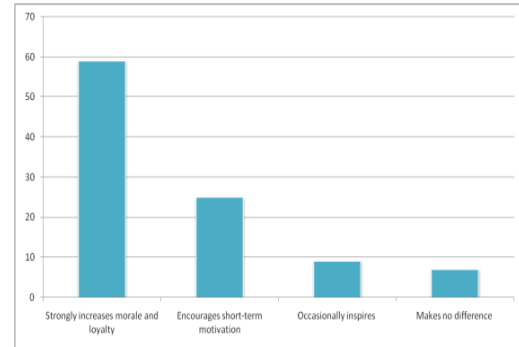
